





## Newsletter - October

As we continue to welcome many new families and children to Meadow Brook, I wanted to go over some general information that will be useful to you all whilst your little one attends Meadow Brook.

**Our Ethos -** *"children are at the heart of everything we do".* 

**Observations, planning and assessments** - The EYFS framework sets the standards to make sure that children aged from birth to 5, learn and develop well and are kept healthy and safe. The framework is for all Ofsted registered early years providers in all settings.

Meadow Brook is a Curiosity Approach setting that uses In the Moment Planning alongside the Birth to 5 Matters as our supporting document of the EYFS.

Staff will complete a one-page profile for each child after they have been with us for 6/8 weeks depending on the number of days they attend. This helps to give us an overview of your child and allows for any early intervention required. If we identify an area of learning that needs further development, we will monitor this and review again 6 weeks later until the child is making progress.

Every half term staff will record on Tapestry up to x3 teachable moment observations and x1 focus child observation.

Staff will also carry out 2-year checks, this is typically done around 30 months – depending on how regularly they attend.

Staff will complete a final one-page profile for each child in June. This assessment will be used by other professionals as the children transition onto the next room/school.
